Description: Perform professional consulting services for Architectural\Engineering, environmental assessment work, and construction engineering and oversight for the renovation of the existing transit facility building and the construction of a transit hub. Services include all phases of architectural engineering from design through project close-out.

Qualification Requirements: Consultants will be considered for selection based upon the following criteria categories: (1) Relevant Experience of Personnel to be used on the project, (2) Qualifications of the Personnel to be used on the project, (3) Proven successful experience working with County Commission project teams participation in the design and construction of buildings, (4) Previous Performance of the firm on similar projects, (6) Quality Control procedures during all project phases.

This project has a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal of 10%.

Following the evaluation of the Statement of Qualifications, the selection committee will interview firms most highly qualified for the services required.
